P.B. Gravely Co. - Acquired by Weyman-Bruton Co. in 1915 dissolved  
by U.S. Tobacco Company of New Jersey in 1923

The United States Tobacco Company of Richmond was founded in 1895 according to Moody's Survey of the Industry.

P.B. Gravely was founded in 1831, J.G. Dill in 1848 — and Weyman in 1822.

United States Tobacco Company was formed under the name of Weyman-Bruton, in December 1911, as a consequence of the dissolution by court decree of American Tobacco Company and its subsidiary, American Snuff Company, in antitrust proceeding. Through the dissolution, the new company acquired:

Weyman & Brothers, Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. Founded in 1822.

August Beck & Company, Chicago, Illinois. Founded in 1880.

H. Bolander, Chicago, Illinois. Founded in 1886.

Bruton & Condon, Nashville, Tennessee. Founded in 1888.

DeVoe Snuff Company, Spotswood, New Jersey. Founded in 1835.

Standard Snuff Company, Nashville, Tennessee.

Skinner & Company, Spotswood, New Jersey.

In October 1915, the company expanded by purchasing the business and brands of P.B. Gravely Tobacco Company, founded in 1831. It purchased Joseph G. Dill Incorporated in May 1921 and one month later acquired United States Tobacco Company of Richmond, Virginia. J.G. Dill Company was founded in 1895 and the United States Tobacco Company of Richmond was also founded in 1895. In March 1922, Weyman-Bruton Company changed its name to United States Tobacco Company, a New Jersey Corporation.
